### **Notice of race**

The Commodore and Flag officers of the Koninklijke Nederlandsche Zeil- & Roeivereniging (Royal Netherlands Yacht Club) and the Nederlandse Draken Club (Dutch Dragon Association),

have the pleasure to invite owners of yachts in the

### **DRAGON CLASS**

To enter in the 2010 edition of the International Dragon Regatta,  
**Grote Prijs der Stad Enkhuizen.**  
To be sailed on the IJsselmeer near Muiden.

#### **1 Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Rule 13.30 of the International Dragon Class rules (crew weight restriction) shall not apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4 The races of each weekend will be a separate series.

#### **2 Eligibility and entries**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Dragon class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing per series the entry form pages on the website [www.dragonclass.nl](http://www.dragonclass.nl), Menu entry: Regatta/Wedstrijden - Entry/Inschrijven.
- 2.3 Eligible competitors shall meet all ownership, class membership and boat measurement requirements as laid down in the class rules and must have paid the entry fee before becoming official competitors.
- 2.4 For each weekend/series the entry and payment or order for automated collection must be received before the preceding Monday, 12.00hrs.
- 2.5 Entrants are bound to pay the entry fee.

### 3 Entry Fees

- 3.1 The entry fees: Opening: €95,- D-Day: €95,- Gemini: €170,- Finale: €95,- shall be paid by bank order or automated collection to:

- 3.2 For late entries or payments the entry fee will be €145,- €145,- €220,- and €145,- respectively.
- 3.3 If an entry is cancelled, part of the entry fee may be refunded, depending on the financial results of the regatta, to be judged by the treasurer of the NDC.
- 3.4 The entry fee includes craning in and out of the water, mooring during the weekend, (limited)beer and bitterballen and three tickets for the barbeque on Saturday, June 26, 2010.
- 3.5 Dutch participants of the Dragon class are asked to pay by means of authorization of the Nederlandse Draken Club to automated collection.
- 3.6 Only participants from abroad may pay the entry fee in cash at the Regatta Office upon arrival; credit cards can not be accepted. Payment by bank will be appreciated.

The fee for the Gemini series includes three tickets to the barbeque on Saturday evening June 26, 2010 for three persons . Extra dinner tickets will be available at €25,- with MY Events. For berthing on regatta days there will be no extra charge.

### 4 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at our website [www.dragonclass.nl](http://www.dragonclass.nl). The sailing instructions are available at the Regatta Office on Saturday May 15, June 5 and 26 and July 3, from 08.30 hrs. – 10.30 hrs. ### 5 Measurement requirements

Each yacht must present a valid measurement certificate upon registration.  
Yachts and crews may be inspected during the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

### 6 Registration and Racing Schedule

- 6.1 Registration for each of the series at the Regatta Office on the first morning from 08:30 - 10.30 hrs.
- 6.2 No warning signal will be made after 15:00 hrs on May 16, June 6, June 27 and July 4.
- 6.3 Schedule:

### 7 Courses and Racing Areas

- 7.1 The course configuration will be of the 'upwind-downwind type', with upwind spreader buoy and downwind gate.
- 7.2 Courses will be laid with a leg length of over at least 1.2 nm if possible.
- 7.3 The racing area will be indicated at the Regatta Office.

## **8 Penalty system**

8.1 The Two-Turns penalty is replaced by a One-Turn penalty (this changes Rule 44.1).

## **9 Scoring**

For each weekend three valid races shall constitute a series. The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A, will apply. If 5 or more races in one series have been completed the worst score will be discarded.

There will be a prize for the overall winner of the four series of the regatta. The completed races of all four series will be scored with the Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.

If a boat did not compete in one or more completed races of the regatta, her score for that race / those races will be DNC.

If 19 to 20 races are completed, only the best 18 will count.

If 21 to 22 races are completed, only the best 19 will count.

If 23 to 24 races are completed, only the best 20 will count.

## **10 Prizes**

10.1 For each of the the four series there will be prizes for the first three competitors.

10.2 The winner of the total regatta of the four series will be the winner for the year 2010 of 'Grote Prijs der Stad Enkhuizen'. This trophy shall be held by the winning helmsman until the next series, but will remain the property of the donor.

## **11 Liability and Insurance**

The safety of a yacht and her entire management, including insurance, shall be sole and inescapable responsibility of an owner / competitor racing the yacht who shall ensure that the yacht and crew are adequate to face the conditions which may arise in the course of the races. Neither the establishment of these Sailing Instructions, nor the inspection of the yacht, in any way limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner / competitor for the crew, the yacht and the management hereof.

Yacht owners / competing crews shall ensure that they are insured against loss, damage or injury to persons, yachts and equipment at any time, however occurring, and maintain third party insurance of not less than €1.000.000 from arrival to the time of departure from the regatta. Competitors are also advised to affect their own personal accident insurance.

## **12 Haul out restrictions**

Yachts shall not be hauled during regatta days that are directly succeeded by another regatta day, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

## **13 Socials**

A barbeque will be organized on Saturday evening of June 26 at the Clubhouse of the KNZ&RV. Extra Tickets are available and will be charged separately. In the Pampusbar it is possible to order coffee and drinks before and after racing. Each day after the racing there will be (limited) free beer and bitter balls in the Pampusbar. After the last race of a regatta there will be a prize giving at the Pampusbar.

### **Venue:**

The Regatta is organized by the Royal Netherlands Yacht Club (KNZ&RV), in co-operation with the Dutch Dragon Association (NDC). The regatta is sailed on the IJsselmeer off the coast of Muiden, the Netherlands (approx. 20 km South-East of Amsterdam). Race management is the responsibility of the Royal Netherlands Yacht Club (KNZ&RV).
